Dear parishioners,

WELCOME!

Thank you for joining us for our weekend and daily Masses. It is so nice to see our families, children with their parents, grandparents, uncles, and aunts attending Masses in person again.

I wish to share with you few updates, some of which were recently communicated to us by our archbishop, Cardinal Thomas Collins.

SUNDAY MASS

Sunday is a Day of Thanksgiving. Eucharist means thanks. It is right and just to give thanks to the Lord our God, and the Mass is the best prayer to offer thanks. God graciously blesses us with everything that we have: life and health, food and shelter, family and friends, intellect and talents, opportunity and resources - and faith. These gifts are so awesome that we ought to be overflowing with gratitude and eager to give our thanks and praise. The ideal is to give thanks every day. Weekly thanksgiving is an awesome way to start the new week!

COMMUNION AT MASS

Communion procedures are unchanged despite the lessening of restrictions in other areas. Both the person distributing communion and the communicant must be fully masked. Once the communicant receives the Eucharist, they are to move two meters (six feet) away, safely remove their mask, consume the Eucharist, replace their mask, and then proceed back to their pew.

THE SIGN OF PEACE

The sign of peace is maintained. A simple bow of the head toward one's neighbour may be offered in lieu of the shaking of hands.

DAILY MASSES

A good way to "return to the public Masses" is to try attending daily Mass. We do celebrate from Monday to Friday, with an average of about 20 persons at Mass. Monday and Wednesday we celebrate at 7.00 pm, and Tuesday, Thursday and Friday at 10.00 am.

LIVESTREAM

We will continue our livestream of some Masses, to accommodate parishioners who for health reason are not ready yet to return to church. The elderly and those with compromised immune systems or other health conditions are encouraged to exercise caution about any outings, including attendance at church. We pray for you and hope to see you soon!

SACRAMENTS

Special thanks to families who have recently celebrated the sacrament of 1st Holy Communion and Confirmation. You give such a faith-filled example to your children. It was so nice to see you at church. Congratulations! Let your light shine.

Special blessings to families who asked to have their children Baptized! Nearly every Sunday we welcome families, and we are so blessed with each of you. Thank you for blessing your children with the gift of faith.

MINISTRIES/VOLUNTEERS WE NEED YOU!

While slowly returning to some pre-pandemic practices (e.g., altar serving, picking up collection, etc.), I invite anyone previously involved in ministries of the parish to step forward, if you wish to help. I thank you!

As indicated by the Cardinal, collections may again be taken up using baskets in the traditional fashion. All Ushers involved in the collection should ensure that they wear masks while undertaking this task and make every effort to ensure physical distancing of two metres (six feet).

WE LOOK FORWARD...

Together with Father Joseph, our associate pastor and our parish staff, we pray for each and everyone of you. These past few months have been very trying, not knowing when a sense of normalcy will return. We are here to serve you and welcome you! Sharing our faith - hope grows here.

The Ongoing Journey To Healing and Reconciliation

We recognize the journey to reconciliation is one that will continue for years to come. As we reflect on the role of the Catholic Church in operating residential schools, we echo the words of the Missionary Oblates of Mary Immaculate in 1991:

"We apologize for the existence of the schools themselves, recognizing that the biggest abuse was not what happened in the schools, but that the schools themselves happened... We wish to apologize in a very particular way for the instances of physical and sexual abuse that occurred in those schools... Far from attempting to defend or rationalize these cases of abuse in any way, we wish to state publicly that we acknowledge they were inexcusable, intolerable and a betrayal of trust in one of its most serious forms. We deeply and very specifically, apologize to every victim of such abuse and we seek help in searching for means to bring about healing."

Please, do not park in the fire access routes, in the handicapped spaces, or on the grass. Additional parking is available at Holy Family School. Thank you!

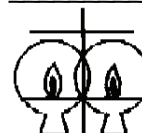


SICK LIST
