

## TRUTH AND RECONCILIATION

If you want to learn more about what transpired during the delegation to Rome, *Salt+Light* has created a helpful resource page that includes daily recap videos. The papal apology adds to the apology from the Catholic bishops in Canada, which was made in September 2021.Pope Francis has agreed to come to Canada to continue the healing and reconciliation process with Indigenous peoples.

The Oblates of Mary Immaculate and the Vatican secretary of state have committed to making residential school documents available to survivors. And the bishops of Canada have agreed to a \$30 million financial commitment to support healing and reconciliation projects, which adds to the more than \$57 million already fulfilled by Catholic entities through the Indian Residential Schools Settlement Agreement.
