### "Why do we ring bells?"

The primary reason for the use of bells is to create a joyful noise to the Lord, as a way to give thanks for the miracle taking place atop the altar.

Liturgical rubrics leave to the discretion of the pastor whether a bell should be used or not.

The tradition of ringing bells in church seemed to arise around the thirteenth century, when the common practice became to ring a bell at the consecration.

Since we are a people of senses, sounds are important in our worship, whether in the quiet of the moment, the singing of a congregation, or the sound of the organ, piano, or guitar. The sound of bells does add to the reverence and the solemnity of the Mass. Most importantly, they highlight in a sensible way, the sacred action taking place on the altar. Therefore, we have a tradition that is not only practical, but also beautiful

Let us make a joyful sound to the Lord! God bless.


